The new appointment system:

Significant progress has been achieved with the new system. It should be noted that the new process is ONLY for Doctor appointments. Remember, you can still call the Practice for appointments if you are not able to use a computer/tablet/mobile phone. The latest update is that in partnership with Witney Library there will be help available with IT/Computer/Tablet/Phone issues relating to the online service. The help is exclusively to patients of the Windrush who require some help or assistance with either NHS app/Engage Consult. The first two dates for these are **12 November** and **10**

RSV Vaccine:

Vaccine clinics will not be opening until the practice receives RSV supplies which are due mid November. Please be aware that if you are eligible for the RSV vaccine the practice will contact you on how to book an appointment.

Clinical trial: NOVA 301 (Norovirus)
